## Instructions

## You will need...


🙆 Strips or coloured paper 🌀 Scissors 🌀 Glue 🌀 Ribbon



**Step 1 -** Cut the coloured paper into 4 strips that are roughly 1 cm wide and 30 cm long.




**Step 2 -** Create a squared corner by glueing 2 strips together (as pictured).




**Step 3 -** Glue the next 2 strips overlapping (as pictured).

**Step 4 -** Now fold the first paper strip creating a diagonal fold. Fold the second paper strip creating a diagonal fold. Continue this folding pattern from side to side until there are only a few centimetres remaining of the paper strips.

Get Creative:



**Step 5** - When you are close to the bottom, glue your strips down and trim the excess paper.



**Step 6 -** Carefully make a hole at the top of your bookmark and thread your ribbon through.





**Ta-da!** Your bookmark is complete. Consider sending it with your pack this month so your friend can hold their place in their favourite books whilst thinking of you.
